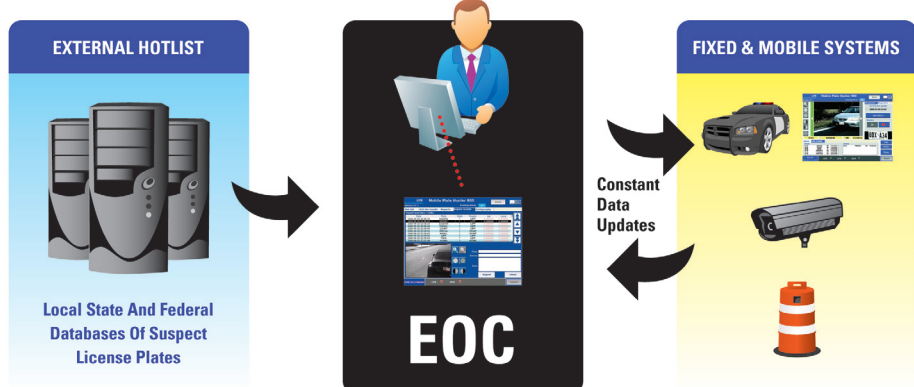

## DIRECT From The POLICE Blotter

**Suspended Registration** — Police arrested Belinda Alvarez, 30, from the Bronx and charged her with operating a motor vehicle with a suspended registration. On March 2, officer Rapisarda was operating an ELSAG mobile plate reader on Rt. 6 and identified the vehicle had a suspended registration, which was then stopped. Alvarez was arrested and released on \$100 bail. She is due in court on April 5.

**Suspended License Plates** — Police arrested Kathleen Dannenhoffer, 37, from Cortlandt Manor. On March 14 at 1:20 p.m. Don Peters was on patrol on Rt. 6 in a vehicle equipped with an ELSAG license plate reader, when the plate reader “hit” on license plates that were allegedly suspended. The vehicle was stopped and a routine check with DMV revealed the license plates had been suspended for parking violations. Dannenhoffer was released on \$100 bail and is due in court on April 14.

**Suspended Registration** — Police arrested Anna S. Eichenholtz, 64, from Yorktown Heights and charged her with operating with a suspended registration, a misdemeanor and an expired registration, a traffic infraction. On March 3, officer Paniccia was operating an ELSAG mobile plate reader on Crompond Road when he detected the vehicle had a suspended registration. The defendant was stopped and subsequently processed at police headquarters. She was released without bail and is due in court on April 7.
